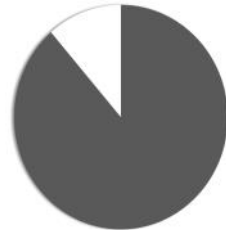

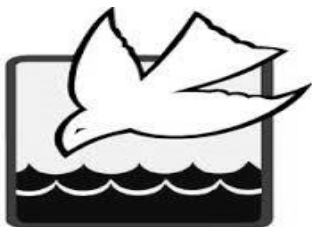

2017 Scripture Memory Challenge. Every family is encouraged to memorize one of the following portions of scripture this year. Take up the challenge. Very few things will reap spiritual growth like scripture memorization:

- Romans 14:1-10

- Romans 8:28-39

Family Devotional

Read and discuss the portion given for each day of the week during your family fun and prayer time. YES, keep it fun! The SOAP Devotional is also included for those who use this daily scripture and prayer plan.

Week of August 7 - 13

MONDAY - Matthew 28:20

1 – Talk about how supporting Missions is important at The Neighbourhood Church. Continue working on this month's memory verse.

2 – Pray for Pastor Jason and Jennifer and their orphanage and feeding programs in Kenya. Show your family where Kenya is on a map.

TUESDAY - 1 Corinthians 10:30

1 – Chat with your family about the fact that we are all tempted to do things that are wrong. Even Jesus was tempted. We need to say "no" to temptation. When we say "yes" to temptation, we end up sinning. Work on this month's memory verse.

2 – Pray for all the students and their families that our Montreal Missions Trip team worked with last week in Quebec. Pray that they will come to know and love Jesus.

WEDNESDAY - Revelation 14:6

1 – Talk about God loving people from every nation. Ask your children if they know children from other countries. Explain that God loves everyone and we should to. Work on this month's memory verse.

2 – Pray for Joy's Home of Hope in Uganda. This orphanage is led by Maureen Torr – another member of The Neighbourhood family. Show your family where Uganda is on the map.

THURSDAY – Jeremiah 17:7

1 – Ask your family what it means if we say we trust someone - for example, "What does it mean if you say you trust your friend?" Then read the verse then ask what does this verse mean? What does it mean to trust in God?

2 – Ask your kids if there is anything they would like you to pray for. Pray for everyone in your family - ask God to help your entire family to trust and have confidence in God.

FRIDAY – Psalm 2:8

1 – Let your family know that this is the verse that is on the wall of our Pinehouse PRAYER ROOM. We are asking God to give us the nations as our inheritance as a church.

2 – Pray for people who have moved to Saskatoon from other countries in the world. Pray that they will get to know Jesus Christ as their Saviour. Work on the memory verse.

SATURDAY or SUNDAY – 2 Corinthians 8:1-2

1 – Discuss how churches that have are supposed to support churches in other places that don't have as much.

2 – Pray for Pastor James and Colleen Guskjolen as they give leadership in the Caribbean and Latin America. Celebrate as a family the memory work done this week.

Week of August 14 - 20

Monday - Galatians 5:22-23

1 - Talk about the things that God develops in our life as we live for Him - love, joy, peace, etc. Encourage your family to be loving, patient, etc. Work on this month's memory verse together.

Tuesday - Ephesians 4:26

1 - Talk about how we all feel angry once in a while but it is wrong to let that anger cause us to hurt people.

2 - Pray for Day in the Park and Martensville Family Fun Day this month.

Wednesday - Galatians 5:25-26

1 - Challenge your family to make sure they are living in the Spirit and not living in the flesh. Talk especially about the three things listed in verse 26 that are not supposed to be a part of our lives as Christians. Remember to have your children looking up these verses in their Bible and have them participate in the reading.

2 - Continue to pray for a larger place for the Martensville venue to meet in and have church in.

Thursday - Psalms 55:22

1 - Discuss with your family what it means to cast your burdens upon the Lord. Work on the memory verse.

2 - Ask each of your family if there is anything they are worried about or having a problem with. Take time to cast those burdens on the Lord in prayer.

Friday - 1 Thessalonians 4:3

1 - Read the verse and take time to talk about sexual purity with your family at whatever age level is appropriate.

2 - Pray for Pastor John as he ministers this weekend on "THE CHRISTIAN SHAPE." It is a message on how we are supposed to live as Christians in light of how we do communion.

Saturday or Sunday - 1 Thessalonians 5:18

1 - Make sure your family is looking up the verse in their individual Bibles. Talk about how as Christians we are supposed to be thankful in everything.

2 - Have everyone share something they are thankful for then have every member in your family lead in a prayer thanking God for what they expressed thanks to each other for.

Week of August 21 - 27

Monday - Gal. 3:28

1 - Talk as a family about how there is no room for prejudice or racism in the church. We are all Christians and all equal and all should be treated fairly and with respect.

2 - Pray for Pastors John and Donna as they give leadership to our church. Pray for Premier Wall as he gives leadership to our province.

Tuesday - John 14:13-14

1 - Discuss with your family that God invites us to "ask" Him for things we are concerned about and that He promises to hear our prayers.

2 - Ask every member of your family if there is something they would like to ask God for. Have a time of family prayer around those prayer requests.

Wednesday - Proverbs 15:33

1 - Talk about the importance of humility in our lives and how that being proud makes God unhappy. Ask your children what humility is. Ask them what kinds of things a humble person does. Encourage your family to be humble and that God promises to bring honour to those who live humbly.

2 - Pray for our missionaries Alexey and Tonia Pankov in Altai, Russia.

Thursday - Ephesians 4:32

1 - Ask your family what things this verse tells us we are supposed to do. Have a discussion with them regarding what each of the behaviors listed in this verse means.

2 - Take time to pray today for members of your extended family. Grammas and Grampas, Aunts and Uncles, and cousins. If they are not Christians pray that they will come to know Christ.

Friday - Genesis 1:27-28

1 - Explain to your family that this is God's plan for life and marriage and that some people at school in the world are going to teach them about "same-sex" marriage. Establish in their hearts a Christian worldview of marriage and family life.

2 - Pray for Day in the Park tomorrow. All the workers, good weather, Tarrant Crosschild as he shares his testimony, and everyone who will be our guests at Day in the Park.

Saturday or Sunday - 1 Thessalonians 5:18

1 - This is an intentionally repeated verse as we seek to build a “thankful culture” into our families. Ask each child to share something they are thankful for in their family and in their church.

2 - Pray for the pastor or pastors who serve at The Neighbourhood Church venue you attend. Pray that God will speak to people who will help with the leading of Small Groups this coming church year.

Week of August 28 - September 3

Monday - 2 Timothy 3:16

1 - Have a discussion with your family about how profitable the scriptures are to us. Talk especially about how God’s Word has especially been given to us to show how to live. Remember to work on the memory verse each day this week.

2 - Pray for people who have been displaced from their homes (or lost their homes) as a result of fires in Western Canada this summer.

Tuesday - Jeremiah 7:28

1 - Talk to your children about how important it is that countries honour and obey God. That countries honour and obey God when they follow the Bible. Pray for your Mayor and write and mail him a note saying your family prayed for him today. If your kids can write it even better!

2 - Pray that Canada will be a nation that follows God. Pray for our Prime Minister, Premier, and your Mayor.

Wednesday - Proverbs 14:12

1 - Explain to your children that not everything we think is right is right in God’s eyes and how that scripture is the filter that helps us know right from wrong. Find a verse on stealing, or lying, or laziness and read it to your family and explain to them that we know we are not supposed to do these things because God says so.

2 - Pray for Horizon College and Seminary. Ask the Lord to be with this Bible College (our Bible College here in Saskatoon) as they prepare for a new year of ministry.

Thursday - Luke 6:35

1 - Go over this verse and list everything that it tells us we are supposed to do.

2 - Pray for everyone in your family and in our church that is sick and needs God’s to heal them.

Friday - Psalm 118:29

1 - Read this verse and ask all of your family to think of two or three things they are thankful for.

2 - Have a couple of members of your family lead in a prayer where they thank God for the things that your family expressed thanks for.

Saturday or Sunday - 2 Timothy 4:2

1 - Talk to your children about how the pastor’s responsibility is to preach the Word at The Neighbourhood Church.

2 - Pray for Pastor John as he ministers this weekend.

SOAP Devotional

Week 1 - Reasons why every Christian needs to be part of the local church

1. To avoid spiritual drift

Day 1: Example of Drifting from God – Saul – **1 Samuel 15:10-29, 16:1-2, 14, 28:5-10, 31:1-4**

Day 2: Drift and restoration – David – **2 Samuel 11:1-27, 12:1-13, Psalm 51:1-12**

2. To be connected to other believers

Day 3: Every believer plays an important function in the Body of Christ – **1 Corinthians 12:13-27**

Romans 4: 9-20 God's promise belongs to the Gentiles as well as the Jews and is appropriated by faith not by circumcision.

Day 1: Abraham's relationship to God was based on faith – **Hebrews 11:8-19**

Day 2: All who put their faith in Christ share the same blessing Abraham received because of his faith –
Galatians 3:6-14

Day 3: If the promise could be received by keeping the law then it would not be the result of accepting God's promise which He gave to Abraham – **Galatians 3:15-29**

Day 4: True circumcision is of the heart and not the body – **Romans 2:23-29**

Day 5: Uncircumcised Gentiles have been united to Christ by faith just as Abraham was – **Ephesians 2:8-22**
